



## MCA School Supply List: Grades 9-12 (Updated May 2019)

<b>ITEMS NEEDED:</b>	
Pencils (English: no mechanical pencils)	Colored pencils
Red pen, <u>and</u> black or blue pen	3 x 5 spiral index cards
Notebook paper (college ruled)	Bible - Preferably NIV or ESV Study Bible
3 or 5-subject composition notebook (English)	Clear protractor
Graph paper - loose leaf	Compass (geometry only)
Graphing calculator (grades 10-12); Preferred – Casio	Students in grade 9 may use their scientific calculator from middle school, or they may go ahead and purchase a (Casio) graphing calculator for high school (either is fine for 9 <sup>th</sup> grade)
High school drama only: 1-subject notebook (Mead 5 star)	1-subject composition book (Health & PE only)
3-ring binder (math)	Highlighters (3 different colors)
Bookbag - no roller bags	Headphones
Flash drive	MCA collared shirt (black) with new logo
Dry erase markers (4 pack) (A-L last name purchase broad tip and M-Z last name purchase thin tip)	1 can of Lysol

\***H**omework **A**ssignment **B**ook (Middle school students will be issued a **HAB**. High school students have the option to buy a **HAB** or purchase their own - HABs are \$5 and may be purchased in the office.)

\*Textbooks must be covered. Covering textbooks with gift bags has proven the best way to protect the books. The jumbo book covers do not work. They end up breaking the spines of the books. We ask that you cover hard and soft cover books in order to keep the resource fees at a minimum. We try to reuse as many books as possible each year.
